Guide to Annual Inspections



For optimum performance, your heaters should be inspected annually by a contractor qualified in the installation and service of gas-fired, low-intensity infrared heating equipment.

To avoid 'no-heat' situations in the middle of winter, Roberts-Gordon LLC recommends that customers get a thorough inspection of their heating systems, annually, by a contractor qualified in the installation and service of gas-fired, low-intensity, infrared heating equipment.

This is not a comprehensive list. For complete product and service instructions, see the Installation, Operation and Service Manual.

Some items to inspect include:

The Area Around the Heater	Do not store or use flammable objects, liquids or vapors near the heater.
Vehicles and Other Objects	Do not hang anything from, or place anything on, the heater. Nothing should be lodged underneath the reflector, in between the tubes or in the decorative or protective grilles (included with select models).
Reflector	Do not use the heater if there is dirt, sagging, cracking or distortion. Clean reflector surface with a damp cloth, if needed. Support with reflector hanger and support strap. Reflector must not touch tube. Overlap must be installed per the Installation, Operation and Service Manual.
Vent Pipe and Outside Air Inlet	Look for dirt, obstructions, cracks on the pipe, gaps in the sealed areas or corrosion. Clean or replace as required. Do not use the heater if there is dirt, sagging, cracking or distortion. Remove any carbon deposits or scale using a wire brush.
Heat Exchanger Tube	Must be connected and suspended securely. Do not use the heater if there is dirt, sagging, cracking or distortion. Clean or replace as required.
Gas Line	Check for gas leaks per the Installation, Operation and Service Manual.
Burner Observation Window	Must be clean and free of cracks or holes. Clean or replace as required.
Burner Head, Cup and Orifice	Remove dust, debris and clear obstructions. Clean or replace as required.
Igniter and Electrode	Replace if cracked, broken, eroded or showing signs of wear.
Thermostat, Sensor and Control Device	There should be no exposed wire or damage to the device or wiring. Replace as required.
Suspension Points	Heater must be hanging securely. Look for signs of wear on the chain or ceiling. Replace as required.
Filter (CORAYVAC® Only)	Check for dirt or dust. Clean or replace as required. (Scan code on back of this page for further details)
Pump (CORAYVAC® , VANTAGE® NP, BLACKHEAT™ NP1 Only)	Check the inlet and outlet of the pump for blockage or excessive soot and clean as required. Check boots for cracking or deterioration and replace as required. Check the condition of the motor mounts. Lift the motor from the rear; look for breaks in the rubber and replace as required.
Couplings	Must be securely tightened around heat exchanger tube within the tolerance shown in the Installation, Operation and Service Manual. Clean or replace as required.
Turbulator	When applicable, the turbulator must be installed within the parameters set within the Installation, Operation and Service Manual. Replace or adjust as required.
Wall Tag	If a wall tag is present, make sure it is legible and accurate. Please contact Roberts-Gordon LLC or your ROBERTS GORDON® independent distributor, if you need a wall tag.
Safety Labels and Signs	Product safety signs or labels should be replaced by the product user when they are no longer legible. Please contact Roberts-Gordon LLC or your ROBERTS GORDON® independent distributor to obtain replacement signs or labels.
